اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَعُوذُ بِكَ (Allahumma innee a'oozhubika) <b>O Allah! I seek refuge in YOU</b>
<b>مِنْ (min) From</b>
الْعَجْزِ (al 'ajzi) Inability
وَالْكَسَلِ (wal-kasli) Laziness
وَالْجُبْنِ (wal Jubni) Cowardice
وَالْبُخْلِ (wal bukhli) Miserliness
وَالْهَرَمِ (wal harami) Senility
وَالْقَسْوَةِ (wal Qaswati) Hard-heartedness
وَالْغَفْلَةِ (wal ghafleti) Heedlessness
وَالْعَيْلَةِ (wa 'aiylati) Deprivation

وَالذَّلَّةِ (waz zillati) disgrace
وَالْمَسْكَنَةِ (wal maskanati) misery
وَأَعُوذُ بِكَ (wa a'oozhubika) <b>And I seek refuge in YOU</b>
<b>مِنْ (min) From</b>
الْفَقْرِ (al faqri) Absolute poverty
وَالكُفْرِ (wal kufri) Disbelief
وَالْفُسُوقِ (wal fusooqi) Rebellion
وَالشَّقَاقِ (wash-shiqaaqi) Dissension
وَالنِّفَاقِ (wan nifaaqi) Hypocrisy
وَالسُّمْعَةِ (was-sum'ati) Seeking fame
وَالرِّيَاءِ (war -riyaa'i) and showing off.
وَأَعُوذُ بِكَ (wa a'oozhubika) <b>I seek refuge in YOU</b>
<b>مِنْ (min) From</b>
الصَّمَمِ (was samami) Deafness (deaf to reason/revelation)
وَالْبَكْمِ (wal bakami) Being mute
وَالْجُنُونِ (wal junooni) Insanity
وَالْجُدَامِ (wal juzhaami) Leprosy
وَالْبَرَصِ (wal barasi) Leucoderma
وَسَيِّئِ الْأَسْقَامِ (wa say'yi-il-asqaam) And from any bad sickness.
